PRACTICAL INFO

RECEPTION

The reception is open 7 days a week: Opening:

Low season: 8.30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.

High season: 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Late arrivals possible (please call to let the campsite know).

____The gate is locked between 10.30 p.m. and 8 a.m..

WATER PARK



- Please follow the rules and regulations displayed on the boards located at the entrance to the water park.
- Showers, foot baths and swimming costumes are required.
- Long swimming trunks or shorts not accepted (only standard trunks and square-leg shorts)
- No pets allowed.

The free-to-use swimming pool is for campsite customers only and cannot be used by day visitors.

Users are required to wear a wristband to enter the water park. If they fail to follow instructions, users will be asked to leave the pools immediately..



No eating, drinking, smoking, and/or running on the pool decks. No shoes allowed: they must be left on the shelves provided for this purpose and NOT in front of the gate. Do NOT use water pistols, air beds, rubber rings, flippers, and inflatable boats.

As the pool is not supervised, children MUST be accompanied by an adult and are the responsibility of their parents.

Please do not leave your belongings to reserve sun loungers. We reserve the right to remove your personal belongings if sunbeds are unoccupied.





The events programme is displayed on the board near the sanitary facilities. Go straight to the specified location when the activity is set to start.

In the daytime:

Manual activities, group games, major events, beginners' canoeing/ kayaking, pétanque competitions, table tennis tournaments, volleyball, hiking, etc.

In the evening:

CANOEING / KAYAKING

Balazuc / Pradons: 8km,

Children must be aged 7 or above and be able to swim.



OTHER FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

- Volleyball court, basketball hoop, pétanque courts (10); football field (11), table tennis tables (9), outdoor fitness area (15).

THE RIVER

The Ardèche River is accessible via either the stairs (13a) or a short footpath (13b). Enjoy the sand and pebble beach. Swimming, fishing (fishing permit required - on sale in Ruoms), canoeina, inflatable boats and water pistols (they're allowed down by the river!).







PITCHES



Camping pitches are rented from 2 p.m. to 11 a.m. Please use specific breathable ground sheets to avoid damaging

the grass on the pitch.

The pitch must be left in the condition in which you found it, without any stones, pebbles, wood, and bins.

For a pre-booked stay, the total cost of the stay must be paid 14 days before the start of the stay.

For an unbooked stay, the total cost of the stay must be paid the day before departure.



SANITARY FACILITIES

The campsite has a central sanitary block (3) open 24/7.

Children's/babies' sanitary facilities (4) including baby baths, raised shower, mini wash basin, children's WC and urinal.

Children must not be left alone in the sanitary facilities.

Chemical WCs must be emptied at the campervan waste disposal point (5).



ACCOMMODATION.



Strictly no smoking in the mobile homes (otherwise the deposit will be withheld).

In case of departures outside reception opening hours. The deposit cannot be returned in advance and will be sent to you minus any bank transfer costs. Accepted methods of payment: French bank cheques, cash, holiday vouchers, and VISA and Eurocard Mastercard credit or bank cards.

In the name of the entire campsite team, we wish you a pleasant stay and are here to help throughout your holidays.





Rented accommodation must be vacated **no later than 10 a.m.** on the day of departure. Remember to book your appointment no later than 2 or 3 days prior to departure.

If you notice any issues upon entering the rented accommodation allocated to you, please report them to reception the same day. No complaints can be taken into account on the day of your departure, or after your stay.



You are responsible for final cleaning, failing which cleaning will be billed.

Out of respect for the next people staying in the accommodation, please leave it clean. We would also like to draw your attention to a few instructions to follow prior to your departure (non-exhaustive list):


- Clean inside the microwave
- Defrost and clean the refrigerator.
- Do the washing up
- Clean the hotplate and work surface
- Clean the coffee pot
- Empty the bins: bin and recycling area at the campsite entrance
- Clean the bathroom and sanitary facilities (plughole and shower tray))
- Shut all windows and doors.
- Do not leave anything in the cupboards.
- Floors: Sweep and mop
- Outdoors: Clean garden furniture
- Turn off radiators or air conditioning.

If a pet stays in your rented accommodation, you can borrow a vacuum cleaner from reception. Reminder: pets are not allowed to climb on beds or sofas (watch out for fur).

QUALITY AND ENVIRONMENT

We are signatories of the **«Camping Qualité» (i.e., high-quality campsite)** charter, andd so, take care to ensure the quality of your stay and surroundings.

Quality covers 5 criteria:

- **A warm welcome**, to contribute to making your stay pleasant and friendly.
- Flawless cleanliness everywhere on the campsite.
- Accurate and honest information. We are committed to providing you with full and detailed information on our campsite, services, activities, and prices.
- We endeavour to provide you with a well-kept, private pitch and guarantee a peaceful and quiet stay.
- We are committed to providing attractive and well-kept surroundings.

Our priorities include landscaping and energy saving.

We do our best to protect the environment. A few examples: The water for the sanitary facilities is heated using solar energy, the water for the swimming pool is heated by a heat pump, we use electric cars to move around the campsite, and every year we plant multiple local trees and bushes...

While on holiday at the campsite, it's important to keep up environmentally-friendly practices.

Let's protect the environment together:

- I avoid waste (water and electricity), don't play with water from taps or sanitary facilities. I take care not to leave the tap on when I brush my teeth or lather up when showering
- I recycle waste. Household waste must be disposed of neatly in the brown containers. A glass container (green), packaging and paper containers (yellow), and a battery container are located at the entrance to the campsite (14).

Dog waste bags are available from reception. • Quand je quitte le mobil-home j'éteins les lumières et le chauffage

- When I leave the mobile home, I turn off the lights and heating
- I remember to turn off the heating when I open the windows of the mobile home
- I don't litter the campsite with cigarette butts, chewing gum or waste (paper, plastic cups, drinks cans, etc.)
- •I don't wash bikes and cars, tarpaulins, etc. with the hose
- •I respect the environment.

THE REGION

SITES TO VISIT

Picturesque villages:

- Balazuc (5km) and Vogüe (12km), which are ranked among France's most beautiful villages
- Labeaume (6km), Lagorce (10km).

Must-see sites:

- The Pont d'Arc (15km) and Gorges de l'Ardèche.
- The Caverne du Pont d'Arc (replica of the Chauvet cave) (15km).
- Multiple caves to visit: Aven d'Orgnac, Aven Marzal,

La Madeleine, La Cocalière, etc.

- "Néovinum" Ardèche wine museum (including wine-tasting) (Ruoms 3 km)
- Bois de Païolive

Multiple walks heading off from the village:

- To Ruoms, Lagorce, Balazuc, Chauzon, etc.
- "Via Ardèche" greenway (walkers and cyclists only) 200m from the campsite heading to Ruoms (2.5km) then Grospierres (13km).
- Climbing site in the Cirque de Gens (200m)
- "Jérôme Mazel" wine cellar (100m)
- "Miellerie des Aires" honey farm run by Cyril Arnaud (Chauzon 2 km)
- Ruoms branch of the Pont d'Arc-Ardèche tourist office (3km).

Cyril Lignac's chestnut & chocolate cake

With their subtle but divine chestnut flavour, these cakes by renowned chef Cyril Lignac make for a spectacular dessert!

INGREDIENTS:

SERVES 4
60g chestnut flour
55g milk chocolate
85g caster sugar
2 eggs
110g softened butter



1

Preheat the oven to 190°C or thermostat 6-7. Butter the individual silicone tins, place on an oven shelf and put to one side.

Cut the milk chocolate into pieces and melt it in a pan over a low heat in a bain-marie. In the meantime, beat the eggs with the caster sugar in a mixing bowl until the mixture whitens.

When the milk chocolate is nicely melted, add it to the mixture along with the softened butter. Mix well, then add in the chestnut flour. Stir well again with a wooden spoon until the mixture is smooth and lump-free.

Fill the individual tins with this mixture, up to 2/3, then place in the preheated oven and cook for 9 to 10 minutes.

When the chestnut & chocolate cakes are cooked, take them out of the oven and let them cool for a little while before turning them out onto dessert plates. Serve with a scoop of vanilla ice cream and tuck in immediately.

The Ardèche is France's leading producer of chestnuts (5,000 tonnes per year, i.e. half of the country's total production).

INFO AND SAFETY

TRAFFIC PARKING SAFETY:

On the campsite, vehicles must drive at 10kph. No traffic is allowed from 10.30 p.m. to 8 a.m. Only vehicles belonging to campers staying at the campsite can be driven on site. Only one vehicle is allowed per pitch or mobile home. This vehicle must be parked in the space provided for this purpose and under no circumstances on neighbouring pitches (even if they are unoccupied) or on access

After 10.30 p.m., please park outside the campsite as access via the gate is no longer possible. In case of a medical emergency, please contact the security guard or call the campsite phone number (displayed on the reception door).

There is a security guard at the campsite all night in July-August. The campsite is equipped with a CCTV system.

PETS: Pets must not be left on the loose. They must not be left alone on a pitch or in a rental property. Vaccination certificates must be submitted upon registration. Attack and guard dogs are not allowed. Pets are formally prohibited from using and accessing sanitary facilities. Pets must be walked on a lead. There is a dog shower on the north side of the sanitary facilities. A dog area is available to walk dogs and let them "do their business".

visitors: Visitors to the campsite are authorised and are the responsibility of the campers they are visiting. They must visit reception to request permission to enter the site, state the duration of their visit, and pay the related fee: their vehicle must be left in the outdoor carpark. Visitors do not have access to the water park. They must leave the campsite before 10.30 p.m.

NOISE: Campsite users are kindly asked to avoid any noise and discussions that could bother their neighbours. Radios must be used at low volume. Car doors and boots must also be closed as quietly as possible.

TOTAL SILENCE IS REQUIRED AFTER 10.30 P.M.

BARBECUES: Barbecues and open fires (charcoal) are strictly prohibited. Gas-powered or electric barbecues (max 2,000W) are tolerated and are the responsibility of users. A shared barbecue is available (12): you must provide your own charcoal and leave the barbecue clean.


